- Working scientifically on plants, animals including human, everyday materials, seasonal changes, light / dark / fire.

Approaches to learning

- Use practical scientific methods, processes and skills through observing, using simple equipment, identifying and classifying, gathering and recording data.
- Identify, name and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals, describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals.
- Identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
- Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, compare and group them together on the basis of their simple physical properties.
- Observe changes across the 4 seasons, observe and describe weather associated with the seasons.

Examples of learning

Pupils are exposed to a variety of materials to explore and understand ourselves, other animals, plants and the world around us.
