

Year 2 Art

Areas of learning:

- 3D art and craft e.g. habitats in a box, model of vehicle
- A study of a famous artist
- Observational art
- Painting e.g. Great Fire of London, plants (linked in with cross curricular topics)

Approaches to learning:

- Experiment/ invent/ create/explore
- Think critically/analyse/evaluate
- Use Art vocabulary
- Explore the visual, tactile, and sensory qualities of materials
- Develop children's creativity and imagination, providing activities that relate to their own identity and experiences
- Use natural/manmade objects and materials with which pupils are familiar with – including the locality in which they live
- Use primary/secondary sources for observational drawing

Examples of learning

- Be exposed to a variety of materials
- Develop an understanding of how colour, shape, space, pattern, texture, line and form can be used to represent their own ideas and feelings
- Explore drawing, painting, sculpture, collage
- Study the work of artists, crafts-makers and designers – describing differences/similarities between different practices/disciplines/ movements and making links to their own work
