

## Year 2 English

### Areas of learning

- Instructions & directions
- Fiction & Non Fiction texts: differences and comparisons
- Study of a book e.g. Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch
- Topic-based poetry

### Approaches to learning

- Each unit Fiction/ non-fiction is studied through related vocabulary, spelling, grammar and comprehension level work.
- Individual/ paired/ small group work to enrich learning techniques.
- Discussions/ presentations – whole class.
- Drama – related activities.
- Sharing writing (e.g. in Assemblies)
- Weekly spelling tests.

### Examples of learning

Pupils are exposed to a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. Reading poetry related to topic themes. Leveled group reading weekly. Differentiate between fiction/ non-fiction and be able to write a factual account and / or imaginary story.
