

Year 2 - Physical Education

Areas of Learning

- Become increasingly competent and confident
- Master basic movements and develop fitness skills
- Participate in team competitive games
- Swimming and water safety
- Understand/use PE vocabulary e.g. control, balance, flexibility

Approaches to learning

- Master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching
- Developing balance, agility and co-ordination
- Acquire basic individual and team skills
- Participate in group games

Examples of learning

- Pupils practice in different contexts and in a variety of activities using various equipment.
- Pupils participate in group/team games
- Pupils play simple versions of games with a partner or passive opponent.
- Pupils participate in swimming lessons
