

## **Year 4 Art**

### **Areas of Learning**

- Portraying Relationships: Investigate how paintings, prints and photographs communicate ideas about relationships and create composition that conveys ideas about people's relationships
- Investigating Patterns: Patterns from different times and cultures
- Studying Artists (e. g. Pablo Picasso): Learning about the artist's life, investigation on his/her range of drawing techniques, create art work inspired by the artist
- Cross-curricular Art: creating art that is connected to topics taught in other subjects such as History, Geography, English)

### **Approaches to learning**

- Topics are studied through primary and secondary sources, related vocabulary, written texts, videos and a variety of activities in the classroom.
- Discussions /research

### **Examples of learning**

Pupils are exposed to a variety of sources and techniques, possible visits to museums and using external resources enrich the topics and provide a wealth of different learning techniques.
