Areas of learning

- Learning the alphabet; using basic rules of pronunciation in reading; spelling rules
- Introducing self and others in fiction and non-fiction texts
- Meeting and greeting people in fictional oral dialogues
- Understanding numbers in written texts
- Living area; my house, my school, in simple texts and through short dialogues
- My things; school items in fictional dialogues
- Colours; colour adjectives- gender, number- through grammar orientated activities
- Body parts in short dialogues and presentations
- Grammar presentation through short texts

Approaches to learning

- Introducing vocabulary of the topics using various resources
- Reading in pairs, role play activities
- Use of drawings to identify new vocabulary
- Listening to short dialogues to understand pronunciation
- Listening to songs to learn new vocabulary
- Discussion about each theme covered
- Self and peer assessed activities
- Working on grammar activities
- Group activities practising vocabulary
- Watching short videos

Examples of learning

- Produce straightforward answers to simple questions
- Speaking presentations and assignments
- Create displays relevant to the topic areas of studying
- Writing single words and short sentences pertaining to the topic area of studying
