### Areas of Learning

- Children's Literature, descriptive and narrative and argumentative texts and essays, biography, autobiography
- Our environment, friendship, music, books and libraries, science fiction, athletic events (Greek as a Second Language)
- Directions, geography (description), supermarket and groceries, profiling others, shopping in the mall, my house (Greek as a Foreign Language)
- Active and passive voice verbs, moods of verbs, irregular nouns and adjectives, participles, similes, metaphors, personifications, compound words, direct and indirect speech
- Ancient Greek Language

### Approaches to learning

- Discussion on language learning and application of skills gained the previous years
- Use of familiar language to improve reading comprehension skills
- Engage in conversations, express opinions and respond to opinions of others
- Application of a range of linguistic knowledge to create written production
- Use a dictionary and techniques for memorising language
- Asking for repetition and clarification
- Peer evaluation

### Examples of learning

Producing descriptive and narrative essays. Exposure to texts addressed to different audiences, will enable pupils to read and write with confidence and converse freely in Greek Language outside the classroom.
