Areas of Learning

- Secure confidence and competence

Approaches to learning

- Perform in a broader range of skills effectively

- Learn how to use and link skills in different activities
- Become more engaged in competitive games

Examples of learning

- Use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination
- Play competitive games, modified where appropriate and apply basic principles suitable for attacking and defending
- Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance
- Compare their performances with previous ones and demonstrate improvement to achieve their personal best.
