Areas of Learning

- Ancient Greek Civilisation– a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.
- The Great Depression in England –an aspect in British history that extends pupils' chronological knowledge and a significant turning point in British history.

Approaches to learning

- Topics are studied through primary and secondary sources, related vocabulary, written texts, videos and a variety of activities in the classroom.
- Discussions /research/applying critical and analytical thinking skills/writing at length/role play
